	Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Hungarian Nationality.</li> <li>➤ Applicants must be enrolled as undergraduate students (full time in residence) at a university in Hungary.</li> <li>➤ High motivation and high level of academic promise.</li> <li>➤ Sufficient command of Japanese to attend classes in Japanese.</li> <li>➤ Recommendation by the university in which applicants are enrolled.</li> <li>➤ Applicants must be able to start classes in September or April.</li> </ul>		
	Scholarship Benefits	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Tuition and fees Fees for entrance examinations and tuition fees at Josai will be exempted.</li> <li>● One return air ticket to Japan</li> <li>● Accommodation University accommodation shall be provided free of charge through the scholarship term.</li> <li>● Allowance ¥50,000 (subject to change) per month will be given through the scholarship term.</li> </ul>		

Duration	Duration of the scholarship is one academic year. It cannot be extended nor renewed.
Number of grantees	A maximum of five scholarships are available per year.
Other points to consider	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ The scholarship will be suspended if the grantee is absent from university for a lengthy period of time, or Josai feels that the grantee is not maintaining standards required for the scholarship.</li> <li>➤ All grantees are required to join the Japanese National Health Insurance scheme during their stay in Japan (premium is approximately ¥20,000 per year).</li> <li>➤ Meals, usage of power, gas and water are to be paid by the student.</li> </ul>

**Application Procedure** (For students who wish to arrive in Japan in September)

(1) Potential applicants must send the required documents to Josai by the end of March.

(Required Documents)

- ◆ Application Form
- ◆ Recommendation Letters from two teachers of their home university
- ◆ Application Essay
- ◆ Transcript of academic records from their home university

(2) Examination of the required documents by Josai together with the Embassy of Hungary (April).
