	Scholarship benefits	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Tuition and fees <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Fees for entrance examinations and tuition fees at Josai will be exempted. ● One return air ticket to Japan ● Accommodation <ul style="list-style-type: none"> University accommodation shall be provided free of charge for the period of the scholarship. ● Allowance <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ¥50,000 (subject to change) per month will be given during the term of scholarship. 		

Duration	The term of the scholarship will be one academic year. The term cannot be extended or renewed.
Number of grantees	A maximum of five scholarships are available per year.
Other points to consider	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ The scholarship will be suspended if the grantee is absent from university for a lengthy period of time, or Josai feels that the grantee is not maintaining standards required for the scholarship. ➤ All grantees are required to join the Japanese National Health Insurance scheme during their stay in Japan (premium is approximately ¥20,000 per year). ➤ Part time jobs in Japan are prohibited with grantees. ➤ Meals, usage of power, gas, water are student's own expense.

Application Procedure

(Students to arrive in Japan in September)

(1) Potential applicants must send the required documents to Josai International University by the end of March.

(Required Documents)

- ◆ Application Form
- ◆ Application Essay
- ◆ Recommendation Letters from two teachers of their home university
- ◆ Transcript of academic records from their home university

(2) Examination of the required documents by Josai together with the Embassy of Hungary (April).

The submitted documents will be reviewed by Josai, the internal selection committee and the Embassy of Hungary.

Applicants will be chosen after the consideration of various factors, such as field of study, language ability, balance of the number of students among the home universities of applicants, etc.

(3) Successful students will receive notification from Josai via their home university (May).

Students who have been granted the scholarship should contact Josai and prepare to visit Japan.
